Important messages

We know you are busy, but reading with your child for five minutes a night can really help their learning!



Support your child to settle well by:

Teaching them to begin to dress themselves and use the toilet independently;



Walking instead of being carried/ using the

buggy;



Saying what they need/ how they feel;



Putting things away when they have finished;
