Important messages

We know you are busy, but reading with your child for five minutes a night can really help their learning!



Schools can be changed if children have brought their books back and their yellow record books in their book bags.



Continue to support your child to settle well by:

Teaching them to begin to dress themselves and use the toilet independently;



Walking instead of being carried/ using the buggy;



Saying what they need/ how they feel;



This week in Literacy, we will introduce a story map of Owl babies to help the children learn to join in with stories and retell them. You can help your child with retelling stories by sharing them, talking about them and bringing them to life using puppets, changing your voice or doing actions.



In Maths we will continue use songs, rhymes, stories and practical activities to learn counting in sequence and noticing small amounts. We will introduce the language of size and shape.

Help your child by using words like **more, a lot, count, how many, big, small, round** and **long** when playing, cooking, shopping etc..
