Please talk to Year 2 class teachers *before* or *after* school if you have any questions or queries.

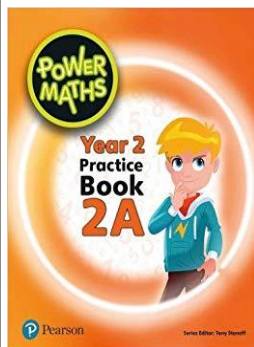
