Listen to the different sounds within the environment.



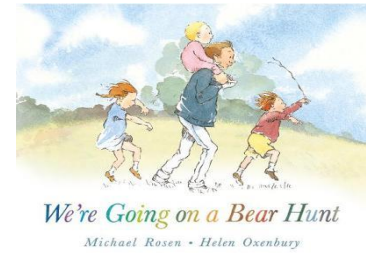
We have song time every Monday: Squirrels and Hedgehogs at 11:15am

Whole school attendance w/e 05/09/18 – 95.6%

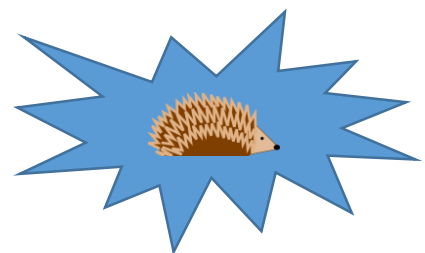
Attendance w/e: 05/10/18
