Please ensure that all packaging is empty and clean.

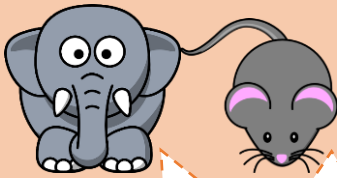
Please make sure children have their name written in their coats and jumpers.

Literacy (We will start learning this story map next week)

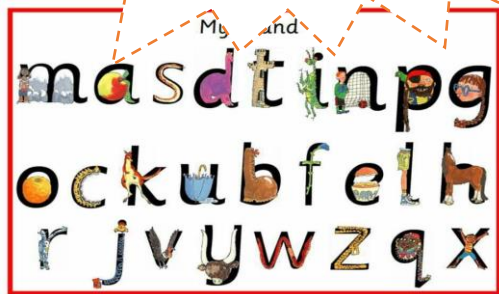
