Maths

Next week the children will be learning addition and subtraction related facts within 10. They will be using pictures to write addition and subtraction number sentences e.g

$$4+6=10 \quad 6+4=10$$

$$10-6=4 \quad 10-4=6$$

Make up some addition and subtraction number sentences to 10 then write four number sentences for each e.g above.

English:

The children will be doing non-fiction text focusing on Dinosaurs. They will be writing what they already know about Dinosaurs and questions about what they want to find out.

- Can you read, spell and write the high frequency words into a sentence? **he, up, no, from, day, I, had, mum & children**
- They will be tested during the week.
