In literacy we will be using puppets to help us tell the story of 'Little Red Riding Hood'

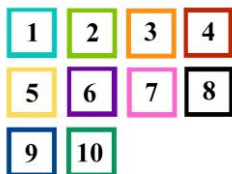
This will also provide adults with an opportunity to promote children's 'personal, emotional and social development.
