### English:

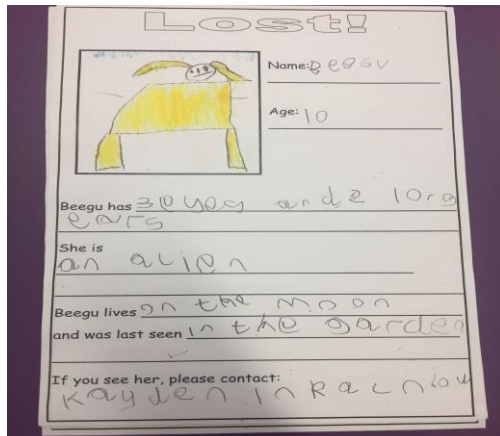
We will be doing story writing. Our theme is space and we will be reading stories about space.
