We explored how they moved and what they ate. Please continue to support your child using technology in a purposeful way to research more information.



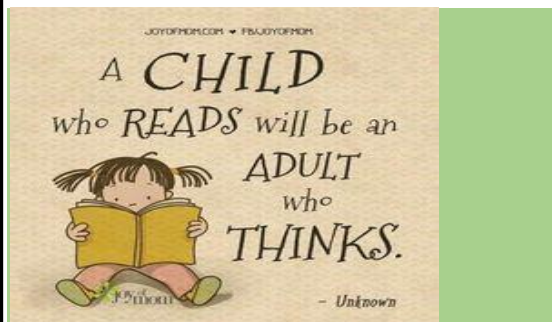

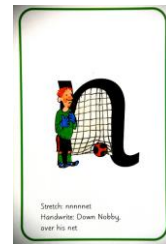
Wow Word
