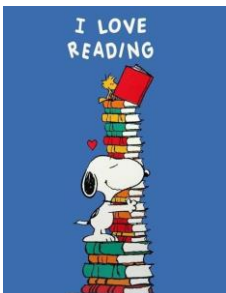

Literacy

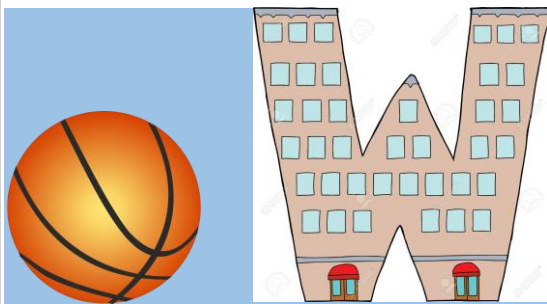
This week for literacy we will be encouraging the children to predict outcomes, to think of alternative endings and to compare plots and the feelings of characters with their own experiences.
