English Focus

Please read and discuss books, ask questions, discuss answers, make predictions and inference with reasons.

Encourage your child to spell words correctly and use correct punctuations.

Write sentences using adjectives, adverbs and conjunctions. Check if they have used the correct tense.

Example: My mum bought me a new book bag. 'bought' is a past tense verb.

Encourage your child to edit their work.

Important messages

- ✓ Please read with your child every day and ask both literal and inference type questions to reinforce their understanding of the text
- ✓ Please help your child to learn their spellings and encourage them to use them in their independent writing.
- ✓ Finally, please ask your child to follow the adults' instructions when they are in school
- ✓ Please make sure that your child comes to school without wearing any jewellery and they don't bring lip gloss and football cards to school

Maths Focus

We will be carrying out lots of reinforcement activities throughout next week which are linked to maths.

Please encourage your child to practice their times tables 2, 4, 5 and 10. Practice written methods ie. Partition method and number line method to add and take away.
