Important message to parents

1. After reading with your child daily, please make sure you have a discussion on what they have read. Please orally rehearse their answers/ responses. This helps them to consolidate their understanding.
2. Please help your child to learn their spellings and encourage them to use them in their independent writing.
3. Encourage your child to use apostrophe, capital letters and full stops correctly.
4. Ask them to edit their writing to make sure it makes sense.
5. Practice mental calculations and written methods on a regular basis with addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

English Focus

Next week, our English focus is writing a diary entry based on chapter 18.


This will be written in the voice of Charlie. They will write in the first person using I, instead of Charlie. They will use personal chatty language. They will also pose questions when expressing their feelings.

Maths Focus

For Maths next week we focus on fractions. This includes fractions of shapes and number. Please discuss with your child where fractions come handy in your daily life when you share and divide things into equal groups.



This is an example of how to share or divide 1 whole into 8 parts. As a fraction we say $2/8$ or $1/4$ As an equal fraction. We can also say there are 8 whole ones. $1/4 = 2$. Enjoy what you find out.
