Our topic for this half term is: Food. Please discuss with your child different kinds of healthy and unhealthy food. Why is it important to eat healthy food?

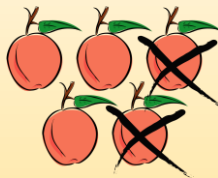


We are also looking at the book of "The Very Hungry Caterpillar". Please familiarize your child with the story.
