Literacy

As we continue learning the story of "The Very Hungry Caterpillar". The children will be sequencing the story using pictures and retelling it using amazing vocabulary.



Support your child by talking about the story and using words like **first, then, next, days of the week, number words and alternative word for hungry** such as 'famished, starving, ravenous'

Maths

We will be supporting the children to develop their understanding of number order and problem solving.

Help your child by playing games where they must find the missing number and challenge them to explain how they know.



Use words like 'next number, one more/ less, count on/back, before/after, bigger/smaller number.'

To support our learning about food, we made fruit salads/ fruit kebabs.



To support your child encourage them to think about which fruit they like to eat make a recipe and a shopping list then prepare and make them... and talk about what they made.
