### Maths

This week we will be solving problems using number facts.

Get 10 lego bricks

Make them into 2 different height towers eg 7 and 3

Is that the only way to do it?

Can you find another way?

How can you check if you have all the ways to do it?



### Literacy

We are working on the skills children need to write a sentence. It is important that children say the sentence out loud, so that they can fix it in their head.

Then they need to remember: capital letters, gaps between their words and a full stop at the end.

We then use our sounds to try and hear all the words we need to write. It helps if children know how to write 'to' 'the' 'is'.
