Maths

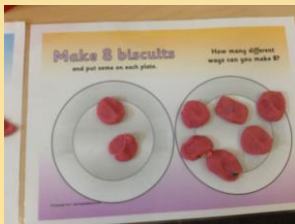
This week we will continue solving problems using number facts.
