Maths:

The children will be learning to add 3 numbers together.

They would need to choose the appropriate strategy to use, e.g spotting number bonds or putting the biggest number first.

$$7 + 3 + 6 = 14$$

$$7+3 = 10 +4 =14$$

BASIC L.O. To add and subtract two numbers.
Adding 3 numbers!

Look for the bond to 10 first.

A) $4 + 2 + 6 =$

B) $2 + 5 + 8 =$

Things to do at home:

Get them to re-visit number bonds to 10 and spot them within number sentences.
