**Caterpillars**- Navya and Gift

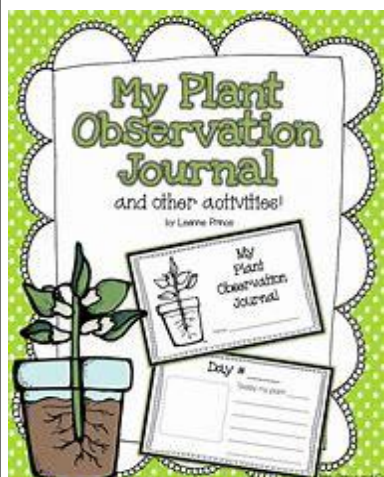
**Ladybirds** – Jordan and Aarav

The children will continue to observe and record changes in their plants.

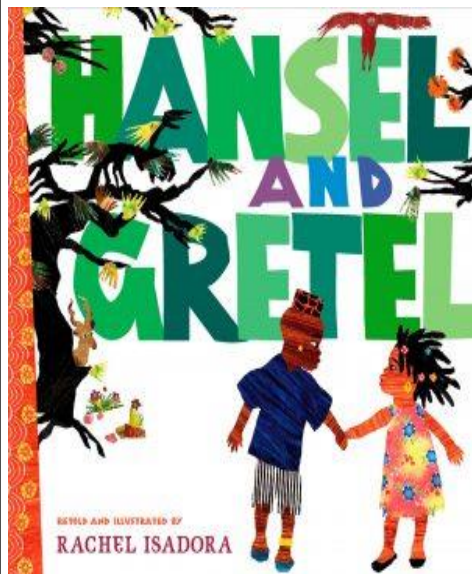


### English:

**PLEASE** help them learn the spellings in bold, at the bottom. Some of the spellings are being repeated because they are being spelt wrongly.

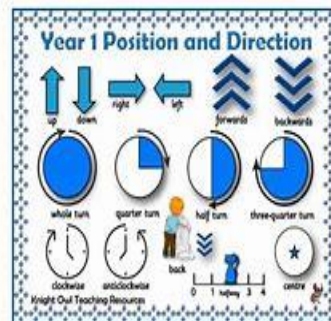
