Two-Step Addition and Subtraction Word Problems
Challenge Cards

Two-Step Addition and Subtraction Word Problems
The cinema has 700 seats. 112 adults and 278 children came to see the film. How many empty seats are there?

Two-Step Addition and Subtraction Word Problems
Doreen earns £24.65 a month as a bus driver and her wife earns £21.85 as a teacher. How much do they earn together in a month? How much more does she earn than her wife does for work?

Two-Step Addition and Subtraction Word Problems
Doreen is saving for money for a new bike costing £220. If she has already saved £39 and is then given £18 for her birthday, how much more does she need to save?

Two-Step Addition and Subtraction Word Problems
A study of 100 people found that 687 were right handed, 176 were left handed and the remainder were ambidextrous (could use either hand). How many were ambidextrous?

Answers
1. 700 - (112 + 278) = 310 empty seats
2. £24.65 + £21.85 = £46.50
3. 100 - (687 + 176) = 37 people
4. (£25 - £12) + £15 = £28 profit of crisps
5. £700 - (£485 + £275) = \$140
6. 200 - (200 + 20) = 0
